The only colors you will use very much of, are the basecoat colors, that you use before class. All the Highlights, Brights, Golds, etc. are just a touch, used in the fishing flies around the outside of the box.

Surface Prep:

Seal and Stain the surface with Minwax Early American & Natural (1 to 3 rati). Sand and tack. When thoroughly dry, tape off edges and put a wash (80% water 20% paint) of Woodland Night on top with streaks of Mallard Green, Cadet Blue and Spice Brown. After top has dried, tape so that the middle section on front, back and sides can be basecoated solid with Woodland Night. This will be half on top lid and half on bottom where it closes. You just need a sheer background for the fish.

Sand lightly after basecoating Trace on pattern lines of fish, letters and fly rod. Trace only the outline of the reel.

Basecoating:

Letters - Raw Sienna

Reel - Raw Linen

Rod - Metal end cap,

Adjusting bracket & base of reel - Drizzle Grey

Cork handle - Lt. Ivory

Rod - Spice Brown
